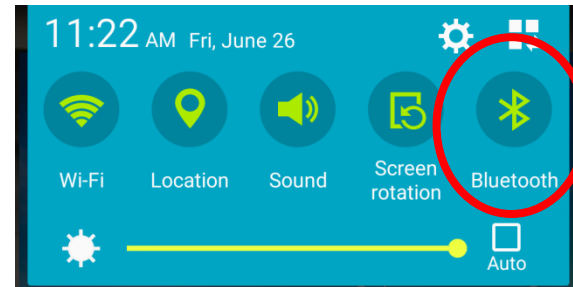


How to *Manually Pair* with a *Supra eKEY Fob*

1. Make sure Bluetooth is on.

Generic Instructions

1. Make sure the device's Bluetooth® is on.
2. If the fob is not listed, scan for devices.
3. Turn on the fob.
4. Select the Supra device (ex: SUPRA-1B09).

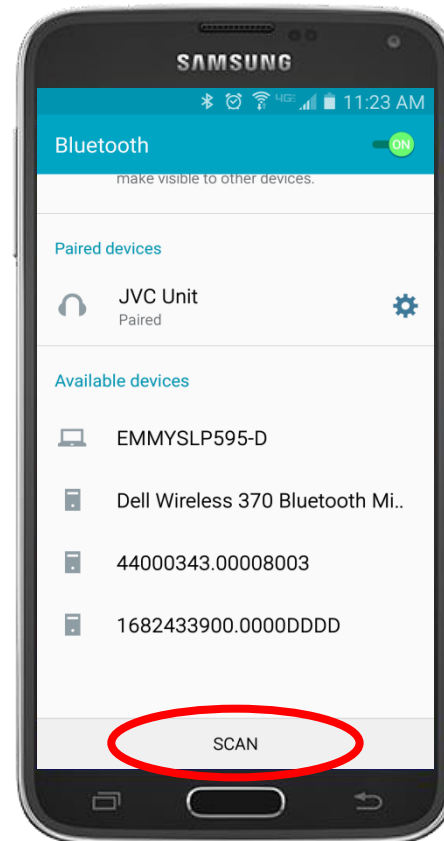

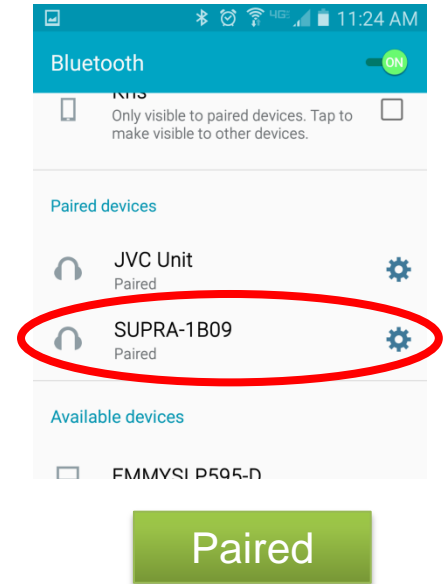
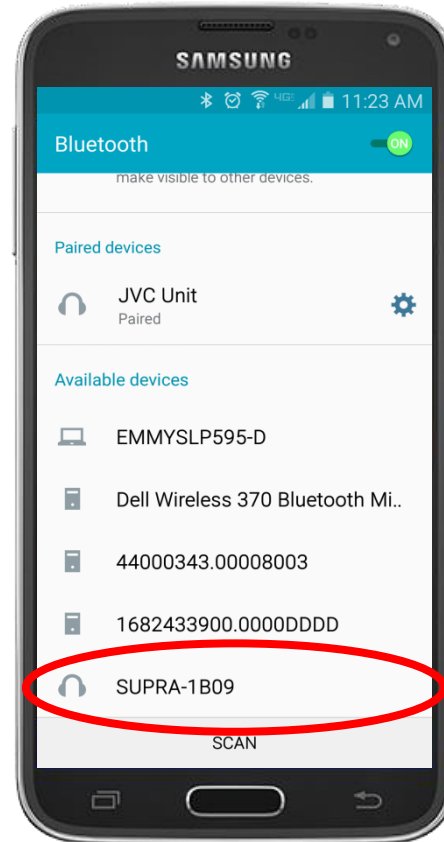
